

BASI Policy Regarding Logged Tours for Level 4 IMS Assessment Course

Please Note: Logged tours must follow the detailed guidelines outlined in the pre-course information and IMS Assessment workbook.

In the event that the logged tours do not meet the requirements then the following applies:

1. If no logged tours are given to the trainers before the course starts then the students will be entitled to continue the assessment on condition that these are provided before or during the course debrief on the last day of the course. If these are not provided then the trainer will be required to fail the student on the grounds that they do have not met the pre course experience requirements and therefore automatically fail the assessment.

In this case the entire course will have to be re-sat and **NO** refunds or compensation will be available.

2. In the event that the logged touring guidelines have **CLEARLY** not been followed and the provided logged tours do not meet or include the requirements the student may continue with the course but must be informed that he or she may not have the relevant experience to complete the tasks assessed and will be at a disadvantage due to this.

They will be assessed as usual.

Following the course their result will be deferred until the minimum required tours that meet the requirements are logged and provided to the Mountain Safety co-ordinator (Roy Henderson).

There will be an administration fee of £75 for this assessment.
